This local event focuses on cleaning up and collecting data about litter on the floodplains and banks of the Swan Creek, Ottawa River, Maumee River and Bay, and other watersheds. 12:30 p.m.	Appreciation Lunch for Volunteers with Free T-shirts, Food, and Prizes at the Lucas County Fairground (south end of Rec Center)

Your group will need to arrange for transportation to and from the work sites and to the appreciation lunch. Groups of 10 or more are asked to have an adult attend Site Captain training at one of two times on the Tuesday prior to the event. Details will be provided when you register.
