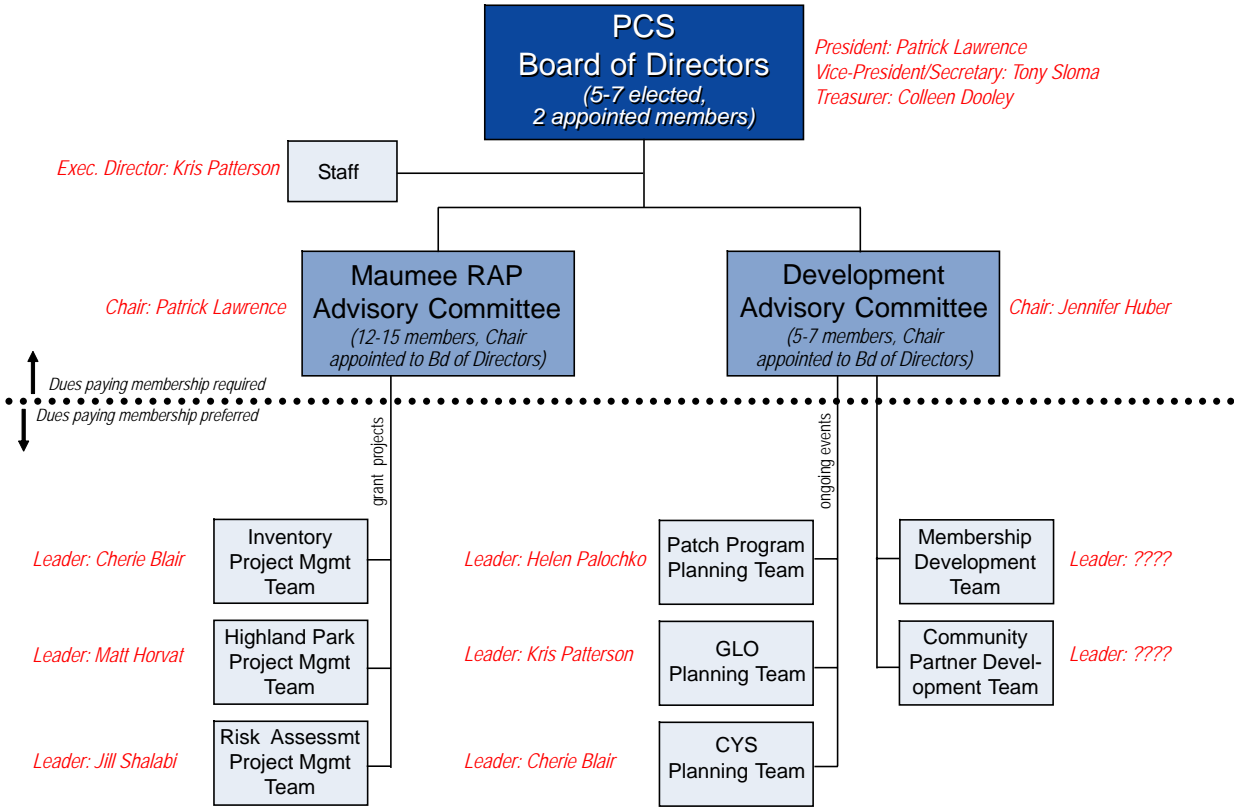


# Membership of Partners for Clean Streams

(all who contribute to PCS; voting privileges awarded with minimum level of contribution)



**PCS Membership, Board, Officers, and Staff**

**Membership of Partners for Clean Streams** - Members are comprised of any donating individual, business, organization or municipality that contributes to PCS. Voting privileges for the annual PCS meeting are awarded to those who have contributed the minimum amount outlined in the PCS Financial Plan. Voting members are responsible for annual selection of the Board of Directors. Membership includes dues paying/voting members and non-voting/advisory/ex-officio members.

**Partners for Clean Streams Board of Directors** - Responsible for all projects, events, contracts, financial & legal matters, and operations of Partners for Clean Streams, Inc. and its committees and teams.

**Partners for Clean Streams Officers** - Responsible for direct oversight of PCS Staff and the Advisory Committees including their operations and activities.

**Staff** - Responsible for daily organizational operations, oversight of the operating budget, receipts and expenditures, financial matters including fiscal reporting and communications with accountant and/or grantors, maintaining organization records, assisting with projects and events, facilitating communications between all levels of the organization, etc.

**Advisory Committees**

**Maumee RAP Advisory Committee** - Responsible for the development and implementation of projects in the Maumee AOC to improving water quality and delisting BUIs including such tasks as reviewing current issues and concerns in relation to the status of the BUIs, recommending and developing projects that will move the area toward delisting, and tracking the status of the BUIs in the Maumee AOC, etc. The Chair has an appointed seat on the PCS Board. Ex-officio non-voting memberships can be awarded to agencies and/or organizations unable to pay dues.

**Development Advisory Committee** - Responsible for development and implementation of membership and donor programs, oversight of outreach and recruiting programs, writing or awarding grants and/or grant matches, etc. The Chair has an appointed seat on the PCS Board. Ex-officio non-voting memberships can be awarded to agencies and/or organizations unable to pay dues.

**Teams**

**Project Management Teams** - Responsible for overseeing and assisting in the implementation of a specific project including such tasks as RFP development, consultant selection and oversight, public education, etc.

**Planning Teams** - Responsible for assisting with the development of events/ programs for that year including such tasks as promotional materials distribution, site coordination, volunteer recruitment and training, donation solicitation, etc.

**Development Teams** - Responsible for the financial development of the organization including such tasks as membership education and recruitment, community partner recruitment, event underwriters solicitation, etc.
