



Clean Your Streams 13 was held on a perfect sunny fall day in the metro-Toledo area. As a part of Ohio's Coastweeks cleanups, Clean Your Streams (CYS) is included in the International Coastal Cleanup (ICC) effort. In 2008, the ICC involved over 390,000 volunteers who picked up over 6.8 million pounds of garbage in 104


countries, including 42 U.S. states. Ohio has contributed to this effort since 1992. Locally this year, 649 CYS volunteers represented 71% of Ohio's volunteers & 81% of the estimated weight collected.

The *Clean Your Streams* volunteers began their day by signing in at one of eight kickoff locations. They were placed on teams to clean up sites along area waterways, including the Maumee and Ottawa rivers, as well as Swan, Duck, and Otter creeks. Volunteers removed litter and recorded what they found on data cards for reporting to the ICC. After a few hours of picking up trash, volunteers from all sites gathered at the Lucas County Fairgrounds ~ new Appreciation Picnic site for 2009. Shankland's Catering, again, treated participants to a free hot lunch. Volunteers were thanked with a *Clean Your Streams* t-shirt and provided with cleanup results. The awards for the Challenge Competitions were also presented at the picnic.

Generous contributions from local businesses and individuals helped to provide the resources for planning the event and for the materials needed for the clean up.
