

Saturday, September 17, 2005 was a drizzly, cloudy day, but that didn't stop nearly 550 people from helping the environment. *Clean Your Streams* volunteers signed in at one of five kickoff locations and were placed on teams to cleanup sites along one of our area waterways, including the Maumee River, Ottawa River, Swan Creek, Duck Creek, and Otter Creek.

Volunteers removed litter and recorded what they found on data cards. After $2^{1}/_{2}$ to 3 hours of picking up trash, volunteers from all sites gathered at Ottawa Park for an Appreciation Picnic. At the picnic volunteers were treated to a free hot lunch, thanked with a *Clean Your Streams* t-shirt, and provided with cleanup results. The awards for the Challenge Competitions were also presented at the picnic.
